14th PRINT FESTIVAL 2026

ONLINE REGISTRATION FROM MONDAY, FEBRUARY 2 TO THURSDAY, MAY 25, 2026.

Summary

Duration: at least one day between May 15 and June 7, 2026.

👉 **OUR commitments**, once your registration is complete:

- ◆ Give you access to customizable digital communication tools to generate your flyers, posters, and social media posts.
- ◆ Give you access to a press release that can be customized for your event.
- ◆ Promote your events on our Fête de l'Estampe social media accounts (@fetedelestampe Facebook and Instagram).
- ◆ Write and publish several Focus articles highlighting your main events (we choose the events based on the communication you provide about your event)
- ◆ Promote the event nationally
- ◆ an interactive MAP on the website

👉 **YOUR commitments:**

- ◆ insert the Fête de l'Estampe logo and QR code on your communication tools
- ◆ insert the Fête de l'Estampe logo and @fetedelestampe on all your social media posts
- ◆ We also encourage you to contact the local press to promote your event

Since 2013, Manifestampe-Fédération nationale de l'estampe (National Printmaking Federation) has organized the annual Printmaking Festival.

The 14th edition will take place in 2026: an event not to be missed.

The Print Festival allows a wide audience to discover all the processes of direct and indirect engraving, lithography, screen printing, and new digital processes.

⚠ WARNING: Please read the entire document carefully!

Where can you organize an event for the Print Festival?

ANYWHERE in studios, art galleries, on the street, in libraries, parks and gardens, museums, schools, in the city or in the countryside, in prestigious or unusual places. All initiatives are possible.

Anywhere in France... in Europe and beyond!

When to organize an event?

Duration: at least one day between May 15 and June 7, 2026.

If possible, include Tuesday, May 26, the day commemorating the 1660 Edict of Saint-Jean-de-Luz, which established engraving as a free art form.

Planned events may therefore begin before and end after May 26 and, if possible, be open to the public on Tuesday, May 26, 2026.

Who can participate?

The Print Festival is open to all those involved in printmaking: visual artists, engravers, amateurs, lithographers, screen printers, gallery owners, printmakers, print collectors, museums, etc. All are committed to promoting printmaking to the public.

How to organize?

Each participant in the festival registers either individually or as part of an association and designs their own event as they see fit.

They take the necessary steps with the prospective venues, choose the times and conditions for welcoming the public, and solicit local media coverage.

Each participant organizes their own digital communication in the form of files that can be downloaded from the website upon registration. If they prefer paper media, these can be provided for an additional fee of €15 (see below).

Each participant agrees to include the Print Festival logo on any communication materials they distribute, as well as the QR code that links to a dedicated page.

How to register?

Registration is via the Manifestampe website, in the section dedicated to the Print Festival. To access it, click on the star at the top right of the menu on the website's home page, then on the registration button. This lists all events classified by region and department, as well as those taking place in Europe and beyond.

The events listed must be related to printmaking.

1/ Each participant, whether an individual, association, institution, company, etc., must register by completing the online form accurately and, if necessary, paying the required participation fee (see below).

2/ Next, each participant must submit their event (description, dates, participants, location, etc.) to their account on the Manifestampe website. ⚠ Your event will only be registered once this step has been completed.

Participation, organization, and communication fees

Registration for the Print Festival is free for all Manifestampe members. For non-members, the prices are detailed below.

Registering for the Print Festival allows you to list your event on the website's interactive map and benefit from Manifestampe's communication channels (national press, social media).

Communication kit

Registering for the Print Festival allows you to download a digital communication kit (online) that you can print yourself according to your needs.

This digital communication kit includes:

- ◆ Fête de l'Estampe/Manifestampe 2026 logo to insert into your communications images to use on social media
- ◆ poster to use as a poster or flyer
- ◆ poster to be customized according to your event for the 2026 Print Festival and according to your format. You have a sample poster and then the same files with blank spaces. You can add the dates, locations, and exhibitors (customizable version).
- ◆ You can download the complete kit and modify it yourself to tailor the communication to your event.
- ◆ All registrations for the Fête de l'Estampe before April 16 will receive 10 free stickers with the new Fête de l'Estampe / Manifestampe logo.

Communication Tools:

Manifestampe has prepared tools to help you promote your event. Once your registration has been confirmed, you will have access to posters and other communication tools to help you: presentation folder, customizable press kit, letters to help you contact local institutions.

To receive 10 posters and 50 flyers of the generic version by mail, you must pay for the paper communication kit (€15) and register by April 15. If you register after April 16, no materials will be sent.

FULL PRICES:

- Individual registration

Free for members of the Manifestampe association.

Members are those who are up to date with their 2026 membership fees. (For information, individual membership of Manifestampe for the year costs €30.)

For non-members: €32 to register for the printmaking festival only.

The digital communication kit is included in the registration fee.

€15 for a paper communication kit to be sent by post, if you register before April 16.

- For legal entities (associations, galleries, etc.):

Free for members of the Manifestampe association.

Members are those who are up to date with their 2026 membership fees. (For information, legal entity membership to become a member of Manifestampe for the year costs €70 for an association and €90 for a gallery.)

For non-members: €32 for the printmaking festival alone.

The digital communication kit is included in the registration fee.

€15 for a paper communication kit to be sent by post, if you register before April 16.

If necessary, multi-site registration: a single administrative registration for events at several sites:

Free for Manifestampe association's members.

For non-members: €32 for the printmaking festival alone.

Option to purchase several paper communication kits to be sent by post to cover all sites if necessary (€15 per kit), if you register before April 16.

This kit can be found in your dedicated space, under the Print Festival section.

(You can download your invoices from your user account (if you are not a member) or from your member account.)

- For institutions subject to public procurement with Chorus Pro invoicing:

Free for Manifestampe association's members.

(Members are those who are up to date with their 2026 membership fees. (For information, institutional membership with Chorus Pro to become a member of Manifestampe costs €90.)

For non-members: €32 for the printmaking festival alone.

The digital communication kit is included in the registration fee.

€15 for a paper communication kit to be sent by post, if you register before April 30.

If necessary, multi-site registration: a single administrative registration for events at several sites:

Free for members of the Manifestampe association.

For non-members: €32 for the printmaking festival alone.

Option to purchase several paper communication kits to be sent by post to cover all sites if necessary (€15 per kit), if you register before April 30.

(We will contact you, and you will send us your contact details so that we can submit your invoice to Chorus Pro, and you will receive the invoice at that time.)

Registration can be done either **online by credit card or PayPal** (with an automatic receipt sent by email), or by check (which takes longer to process).

> Please pay by credit card or PayPal if possible. Checks, made payable to Manifestampe, should be sent to the postal address provided on the website to Manifestampe-Fédération nationale de l'estampe.

> **Participation fees are non-refundable.**

Communication:

Manifestampe devotes significant resources to managing registrations, national communication (in the print media and online), creating and sending downloadable or physical communication materials (posters, flyers, stickers, summaries of all events), monitoring your event on the dedicated website, communicating on social media (Facebook and Instagram), newsletters, and Focus articles.

 **Important:** to facilitate communication on social media, we invite you to mention **@fetedelestampe** and add the hashtag **#FDE2026** to your posts, stories, and reels, and to subscribe to share events in your region. It is also advisable to systematically add our account ID, **@fetedelestampe**, to your posts on Instagram and Facebook. This will make it much easier for us to share your posts with as many people as possible.

 **Important:** we provide you with a presentation file that you can customize at <https://www.manifestampe.org/fete-de-estampe/2026>.

There you will find:

a press release

a press kit

information about the Fête de l'Estampe.

We invite you to download it, complete it, and distribute it widely to the local press, your town hall, or any other person or institution likely to help promote the event. With effective communication and promotion, coupled with our national communication campaign, your event has every chance of being a success.

We have also developed tools to help you contact your local town halls and encourage them to promote your event more widely.

 **Tip:** based on your feedback in the 2025 Print Festival survey, we recommend pooling your events and issuing joint communications. Events that did this were sometimes hugely successful. During registration and throughout the festival, a series of FOCUS articles will be published to highlight your initiatives and events. Please feel free to send us your information, press kits, photos, and videos to the following email address: fetedelestampe@manifestampe.org (subject line: FOCUS). By organizing an event as part of the Print Festival, you agree to send us any articles or other mentions of your event so that we can share them in the FOCUS series.

 **Reminder** about multi-site registration: for an association/institution that has validated a multi-site registration, each site undertakes to communicate with all event participants and all the different venues. We have a contact person (an administrative registration) and this contact person undertakes to manage the various registered sites.

 **Reminder:** the program brochure is available online only and lists all events by region, department, and country. It can be downloaded in PDF format from the website starting May 10. Each participant is responsible for the information provided on the registration form and authorizes its dissemination by Manifestampe.

With regard to the visuals you send us (posters, exhibitions, works, etc.), please remember to obtain the consent of the people appearing in the photographs. When sending us the visuals, please also provide us with the name of the author of each photograph. By sending these documents, you authorize Manifestampe to freely use and distribute these visual documents related to the proposed events.

The Fête de l'Estampe/Manifestampe logo must appear on all participants' communication materials. Manifestampe cannot be held responsible for the cancellation of an event.

 Please note:

- For everyone: please provide the full address where you would like the stickers and communication documents to be sent, if you have requested them, along with the first and last name of the person who will receive them. If the mail is returned due to an incorrect address provided by you, it will not be resent.
- Register quickly to take full advantage of our social media networks. (See the "Communication" section of the rules).
- By registering for the 2026 Print Festival, you agree to these rules.
